



# what to bring to camp

Drop-off July 22 • 11 AM | Pick-up July 28 • 11:30 AM

Camp is 7 days and 6 nights. There are no laundry facilities so please make sure to pack enough clothing for all 7 days!

Please clearly mark all items with the camper's name.

Camp Quest is not responsible for lost items.

## Required Items in bold

### Clothing & Accessories

- 7-8 Shirts
- 7-8 Pairs of pants/shorts/skirts  
At least one pair of jeans or long pants and one long-sleeved shirt are recommended
- 7-8 Pairs of socks
- 7-8 Pairs of underwear
- Night wear  
Pajamas, night gown, t-shirt and shorts, etc. to sleep in
- 1 Pair of closed-toe shoes.  
Preferably sneakers. Closed-toe hiking sandals are OK  
Please wear shoes you don't mind getting muddy
- 1 Pair of flip flops  
For use in the shower, pool area, and cabins only
- Bathing suit
- Hat, cap or bandana
- Jacket and/or sweatshirt
- Poncho or rain coat
- Sunglasses

### Personal hygiene items

- Towels & washcloths  
At least 2 towels are suggested.
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Soap & shampoo
- Deodorant
- Hair brush, comb  
*If needed*
- Hair ties, headbands, etc.  
*If needed*
- Feminine hygiene products  
We stock all bathrooms with feminine hygiene products as we believe products like these should be just as available as toilet paper.

### Bedding

- Sleeping bag or twin size bedding
- pillow

### Miscellaneous

- Backpack  
Large enough to carry sunscreen, bug spray, water bottle and other items a camper may want to keep with them throughout the day. Draw-string back packs are a great option
- Sunscreen  
Sunscreen is required and provided at the pool, but campers should bring their own for other outdoor activities.
- Bug Spray  
We recommend a spray that contains DEET.
- Canteen or water bottle
- Flashlight & extra batteries
- Fan  
Small personal fan, box fans, oscillating fans, etc.  
All cabins have an attic fan, but having extra fans can help with keeping cool.
- Stationery, envelopes & stamps
- Pens/Pencils
- Diary/Journal
- A ball glove
- Binoculars
- Books
- Cards & card games  
Please refrain from bringing collectable card games (*Magic the Gathering, Pokemon, etc. We are cool with campers playing these games but these games require each person to have a deck to play and we do not want a valuable card to go missing/become ruined by water etc.*)
- Board games
- Diary/journal

Please leave these items at home: Food Items • Cell Phones • Cameras • Music Players • Hand Held Games • Tablets

If one of these items is found at camp is dropped of, the item will be confiscated

and placed in a bag with their name on it, kept in a safe place, and returned to the person picking them up.
