



Acknowledgment of Understanding of Camp Quest Policies

The following is Camp Quest Kansas City's policy information for the safety and protection of each child.

"We (camper(s) and parent or legal guardian) understand that it is the responsibility of each camper to participate in the whole program, including activities of work, play, values sharing, and living together. We understand and support camp policies prohibiting campers from bringing weapons to camp, and from possessing or using drugs (except in accordance with the camp medication policy), tobacco products, or alcoholic beverages while at camp. We recognize that campers must follow safety instructions, remain in areas designated by staff, refrain from behavior that is harmful to themselves or others, and otherwise act in a manner that maintains a safe, tolerant, and fun atmosphere for all campers. Failure to adhere to camp policies may cause the Camp Director to dismiss a camper, without refund of camp fees."

"We understand that campers may not bring electronic devices to camp, including cell phones, cameras, music players or e-readers. Devices that have the capability to send or receive phone calls or other communications (including email or text messages) are not permitted. We further understand that failure to adhere to this policy may result in the Camp Director taking and holding the device in safekeeping until the camper departs. We understand that Camp Quest Kansas City is not responsible for lost or stolen items."

"We understand that campers will not be permitted to keep food items in their cabins. Camp Quest will provide campers with all necessary nutrition so it is not necessary for campers to bring their own food."

"I (parent or legal guardian) understand that I am not to leave my child at Camp Quest Kansas City unless a camp staff member is there to receive and supervise my child."

"I understand that campers will not be allowed to leave the camp or camp activities with an unauthorized person. Any person other than a parent or legal guardian named on the Camper Registration Form will not be allowed to pick up the camper unless prior arrangements have been made with the Camp Director by a parent or legal guardian named on the Camper Registration Form."

"I am aware that my child will have the opportunity to participate in camp activities which may involve a degree of risk, and I approve his/her participation in such activities. I understand that accidents can occur. Recognizing that the camp will do its best to ensure a safe and enjoyable camping experience, I hereby release Camp Quest Kansas City, Camp Quest National and all its affiliates, from any and all responsibility and liability of any nature resulting from my child's participation in any camp activity."

I hereby authorize the Medical Leader and their Camp Leader designees to administer routine over-the-counter (OTC) medications to my child (please see list of OTC medications we currently keep in stock in our [FAQ](#) page) . I hereby give permission to the medical personnel selected by the Camp Leaders to order x-rays, routine tests, treatment, and necessary medically-related transportation for my child for routine health care and in emergency situations. In the event I cannot be reached in a medical emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the Camp Leaders to secure and administer all necessary treatment, including hospitalization, injection, anesthesia, or surgery for the child named above. The Camp Leaders have permission to obtain a copy of my child's health record from providers who treat my child, and these providers may talk with the Camp Leaders about my child's health status.

"I understand that my child may be photographed or video-recorded, and consent to the photographs and video recordings being used for promotional purposes by Camp Quest Kansas City, Camp Quest Nation and/or its Affiliates. Camp Quest requires all parents to consent to this usage because managing those permissions would place an excessive burden on our volunteers and would be disruptive to the camper's experience."

" I understand that Camp Quest occasionally attracts the attention of reporters, who find the idea of our camp makes for a great special interest story. Media coverage of Camp Quest has generally been very positive. It is Camp Quest Kansas City' policy to allow media access to video of the Camp Session, but we will not release camper's names or grant interviews without prior parental consent."
